Accommodation	<p>It is not so easy to find rooms in Rorschach or St.Gallen. The PHSG students often share flats. Exchange students might find a place in one of these flats, or they can rent private accommodation (cost of room = about CHF 650 /~ € 650 per month). The International Office will help you to find an accommodation.</p>
Health Insurance	<p>For international students coming to Switzerland it is compulsory to have appropriate health insurance.</p>
Arrival	<p>It is highly recommended for students to arrive with ample time before the beginning of the semester (preferably not at a weekend) in order to plan their study programme and to optimize their opportunities.</p>
