Accommodation	It is not so easy to find rooms in Rorschach or St.Gallen. The PHSG stu- dents often share flats.
	Exchange students might find a place in one of these flats, or they can rent private accommodation (cost of room = about CHF 650 /~ € 650 per month). The International Office will help you to find an accommodation.
Health Insurance	For international students coming to Switzerland it is compulsory to have appropriate health insurance.
Arrival	It is highly recommended for students to arrive with ample time before the beginning of the semester (preferably not at a weekend) in order to plan their study programme and to optimize their opportunities.
