| Accommodation | <p>The International Office assists in finding accommodation. PHSG students often share flats. Exchange students might find a place in one of these flats, or they can rent private accommodation (cost of room = about CHF 650 - 700 per month).</p> |
| Health Insurance | <p>For international students coming to Switzerland it is compulsory to have appropriate health insurance.</p> |
| Arrival | <p>It is highly recommended for students to arrive with ample time before the beginning of the semester (preferably not at a weekend) in order to plan their study programme and to optimize their opportunities.</p> |
